## *Project objectives*

---

- ◆ To educate and raise awareness of 1500 young people, aged 13-18, directed to changing their attitudes and behaviour towards the GBV, resp. ADV;
- ◆ To strengthen multi-agency cooperation through training 225 stakeholders and relevant professionals with regard to address issues related to GBV;
- ◆ To assess how activities and the use of deliverables have led to attitudinal and behavioural changes towards the GBV through involvement of 1000 young people in the project evaluation process;
- ◆ To increase the EU practice of applying child participation to prevent ADV.

## *Activities*

---

- ◆ Organization of 5 workshops in the partner countries for 150 professionals – representatives of the child protection system, education, healthcare, sport - to increase their capacity to deal with prejudice and gender stereotypes and to improve multi-agency cooperation;
- ◆ Identification of the training needs of the children and youths through conducting a research on their perception of gender-based violence, respectively adolescent dating violence;
- ◆ Development of a Manual for working with young people and creation of a digital learning tool directed to changing attitudes and behaviour, related to GBV in adolescence;
- ◆ Organization of 5 trainings for 75 professionals who will work directly with young people;
- ◆ Delivering training to 500 adolescents in Bulgaria, Greece, Italy, Portugal and Spain with the aim of increasing their understanding of gender equality, healthy relationships, gender stereotypes and roles and acquiring skills to address and resolve conflicts in their relationships;

- ◆ Awareness raising activities for 1000 adolescents initiated and implemented by young people among their peers;
- ◆ Impact assessment of project activities;
- ◆ Dissemination of project results on national and European level – national dissemination events, final EU conference, project website, brochure.
